Koha is the world's first free and open-source library automation software. It is a fully featured, scalable library management system. Koha is used worldwide by Public, Academic and Special Libraries. The name comes from a Māori term, which means a gift or donation. The user interface of Koha is very configurable and adaptable and has been translated into many languages. Koha has most of the features that would be expected in a good Integrated Library Management System (ILMS).
